Dear "Connect Worlds, Mundos Unidos" Family,

The El Paso High School Dual Language Magnet Program was established at El Paso High School in the Fall of 2003. It was the first of its kind in the city touting a combined dual language/gifted and talented curriculum. In the spring of 2007, the program graduated its first cohort of 11 students. Since then, the program has graduated almost 300 students and have "Connecting Worlds" alumni at most major private and public universities in the nation. Among our alumni we have doctors, lawyers, Google employees, artists and film directors.

Currently the El Paso High Dual Language Magnet Program has 278 participants and offers over 20 dual language courses. Our program is recognized nationwide for its innovative curriculum that at its core emphasizes the importance of multilingualism, but also values multiculturalism as well. One such newly added course that explores an aspect of our regional culture is our world dance folklorico class. Through this academic course, we have been able to establish El Paso High School's first ever folklorico dance troupe.

In just a few short months, *Ballet Folklorico Tecuani of El Paso High School* has been invited to perform for several community events. As part of their academic study of folklorico, students learn and perform different regional dances (7-15) from all over the Americas. This entails the purchase and maintenance of several elaborate costumes. The popular "Jalisco" regional dance for example has a full multi-layered skirt and elaborate ruffled top, a headpiece a dance shawl and boots. The cost for just one complete costume is approximately \$375. *Tecuani* currently has 16 female dancers and 1 male dancer. *Tecuani* has been making due by borrowing costumes or has performed in their practice skirts.

On behalf *Ballet Folklorico Tecuani of El Paso High School* I am appealing for financial assistance so that our dancers can perform in authentic regional costuming and be true to the historical significance of the folklorico art form. Donations are accepted daily by the El Paso High School's Business Agent, Ms. Virginia Marquez.
