High School Credit "The Basics"



- All classes earn .5 credit per semester
- A course usually has related parts for each semester (example: Algebra 1A and 1B)
- Grades:
 - 10% is final exam
- To earn course credit: must have 70% grade or higher

Types of High School Courses

- General
- Pre-Advanced Placement (P-AP)
- Advanced Placement (AP)
 - Nationally-recognized College Prep Courses
 - Earn college credit with passing scores on AP exams
- Dual Credit (DC) /Dual Enrollment (DE)
 - Community College Courses
 - University of Texas at Austin "OnRamps" Dual Enrollment
- Dual Language or Magnet-Specific Local Courses


